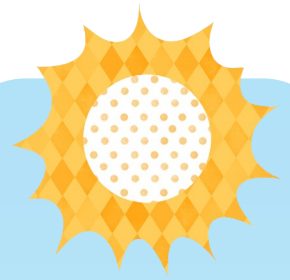

TCOA supports seniors 60 and older through its Home-Delivered and Congregate Meal programs, promoting health, independence, and interactions across Terrebonne Parish. Served Monday through Friday, all meals meet USDA guidelines and offer more than nourishment to approximately 900 seniors daily.

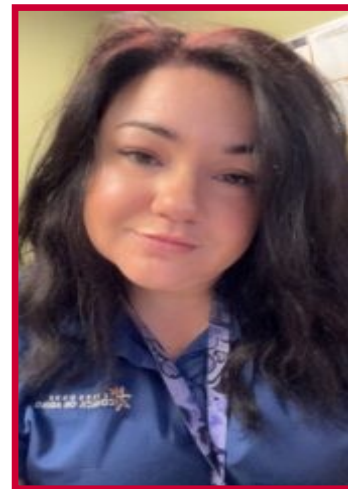
